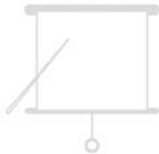

National Dental Centre Singapore (NDCS) is the largest specialty referral centre for oral healthcare. It comprises of multi-disciplinary teams, leads in the training of dental professionals in Singapore and support advancements in dentistry research.



National Heart Centre Singapore (NHCS) houses the largest number of heart specialists in Singapore and is the regional referral centre for cardiovascular diseases.



National Neuroscience Institute (NNI) is the national and regional centre for the treatment, education and research in the neurosciences. 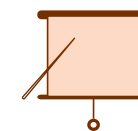
Clinical

- Provide nursing care and patient education
- Implement and evaluate nursing care activities for patients and direct operational work
- Perform a variety of invasive and non-invasive procedures related to care plans
- Act as a liaison between patients and families and multi-disciplinary health care teams



Research

- Explore ways to improve health, healthcare services and outcomes
- Identify research questions, design and conduct research studies
- Write articles for publications in professional journals
- Communicate and liaise with research participants and multidisciplinary teams



Educator

- Supervise clinical instructors in conducting classroom teaching
- Develop curriculum for training programmes to meet various needs
- Identify, plan, implement, coordinate and evaluate courses, attachments and fellowship programmes
- Mentor and coach students attached to the institutions



Informatics

- Define and develop plans that enable integration of information systems and technologies to the patient care workflow
- Guide nurses in the clinical area on the use of information systems and technologies
- Monitor and evaluate information systems and technology outcomes and take timely intervention
- Serve as a liaison, resource person and preceptor for nurses and trainees for information technology related issues



Management

- Monitor, evaluate and take corrective action on care rendered by the team of nurses to maintain the highest standard of care
- Plan and coordinate yearly department work-plan, and budgeting
- Ensure staff comply with hospital policies and procedures related to patient care
- Engage and motivate staff for professional and advancement through career planning and counselling

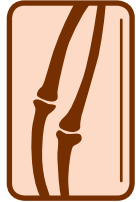

Use goal-specific activities to help patients overcome their physical, cognitive or mental health challenges to independently perform tasks which are part of daily living.



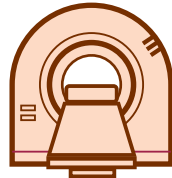
Pharmacist

Help patients optimise their mobility after an injury, surgery or illness to improve their functional capacity, joint mobility and balance, build muscle strength and relieve pain.



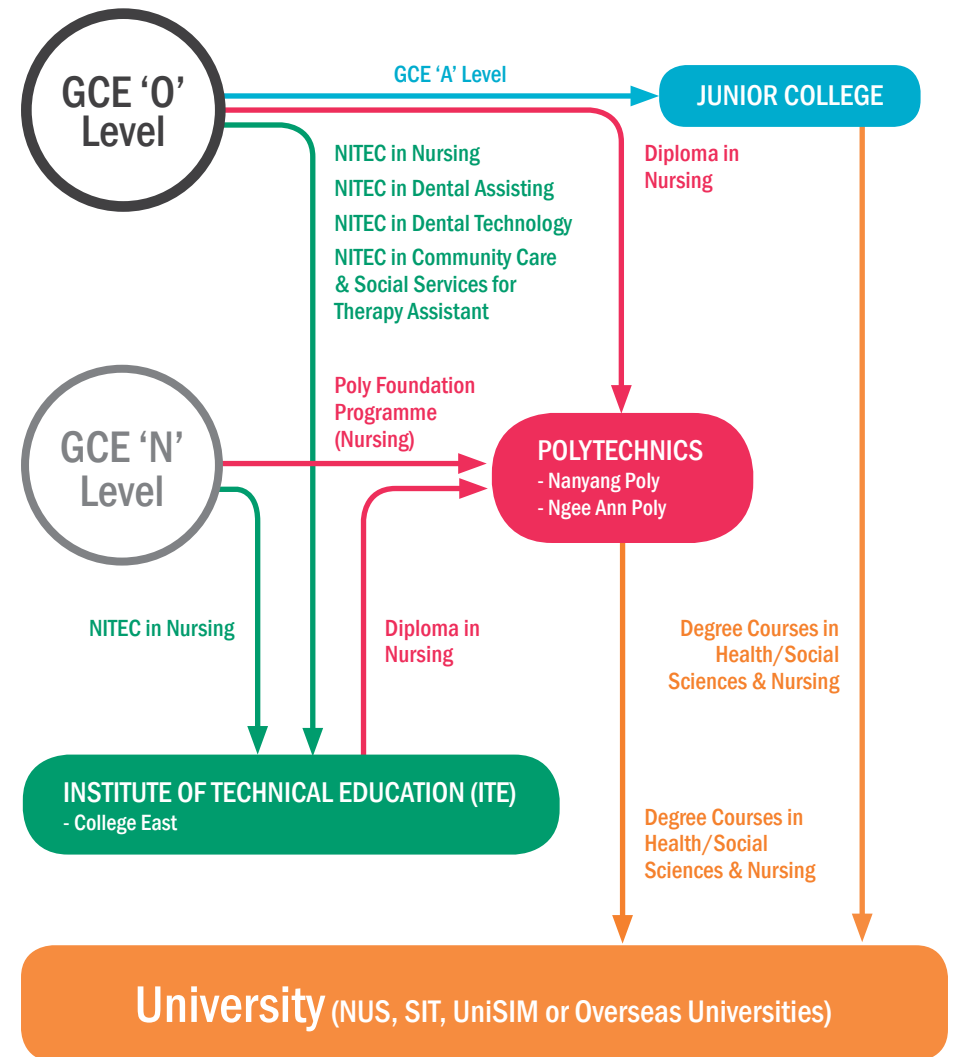
Radiation Therapist
